Are the spools and boxes that Kodak manufactures acid and lignin free and, can they be used for long term storage?

The Kodak manufactured 16mm and 35mm Black Plastic Spools are made from polystyrene and the Black Plastic Microfilm Boxes are made from polypropylene.

Both the spools and storage boxes are acid free and lignin free and may be used as enclosure materials for long term keeping of microfilms as per the ANSI/ISO Standards below.
